Start and Finish Times:

Please note: Pupils should be in their classroom by 8.45 am so that lessons are able to start promptly. They should not come in through the gate at 8.45 am. Pupils who are regularly late miss out on important learning. This puts them at a disadvantage to their peers.			
Finish Time	3.15 pm	Gates open at 3.05 pm - please collect your child by 3.15 pm	

Late Arrivals: We do understand that traffic in Hillingdon can be unpredictable and that sometimes events happen and a child is late to school. We would much prefer a child to arrive late than not come to school.

However, regular lateness at school is not acceptable as pupils miss valuable learning. It is important that we teach our pupils that being punctual is important as we prepare them for life in modern Britain. Punctuality at work will be an expectation. It is a parent's responsibility to ensure they arrive at school on time.

All gates will close at 8.45 am apart from the main gate on the Uxbridge Road. **Closing the gates maintains the school's security during the school day.**



Pupils arriving after 8.45 am will be recorded as late, alongside the reason for lateness and will need to enter the school via the school gates on the Uxbridge Road from this time.
