Dear Parents and Carers,

Main School Uniform and PE Uniform

We hope you and your child/children have enjoyed the summer holidays. We look forward to welcoming children back to school tomorrow (Thursday 4th September).

Please find below information to support you in preparing for your child's return to school; all students should return to school in the correct school uniform.

During 2025/2026 we are keen to continue to improve the overall smartness of our uniform; we ask parents to consult the information on the school website and ensure that all pupils are in the correct uniform.

Information about our school uniform can be found on the school website. You will find it by clicking on 'News and Events' and then clicking on '**Information for September 2025**'. You will also find on their information about lunches, term dates and recent letters that have gone out for the new term.

We can confirm that during 2025/2026 pupils should wear their PE uniform on two days each week, on the days when they have PE. Pupils have at least two hours of PE on different days. Please refer to the next page which shows PE days for each class. In particular we are keen that all **pupils wear a navy sports kit (NOT BLACK) with a white t-shirt**. Children should not be wearing any jewellery on PE days; earrings should be taken out at home. If pupils are attending an after school sports club then they may wear their PE uniform on the day(s) of that club. For the other days they should wear their main school uniform.

Bags - Important for Health and Safety in the School - No backpacks for Year 1 to Year 5.

Students in Year 1 to Year 5 should not bring backpacks into school. They should bring a book bag (it doesn't have to be the school one). This means our corridors remain less congested making it easier, in the unlikely event we need to evacuate the school, as well as making it a more pleasant environment to work in on a day-to-day basis. A book bag fits into your child's tray and ensures it is easily accessible for your child to efficiently organise their belongings.

Nursery, Reception and Year 6 are able to have backpacks/ drawstring bags. Their classrooms are located in the newer building where cloakroom provision is more generous. We know that many of the Nursery and Reception children need to bring a change of clothes and backpacks are used for this purpose. For our Year 6 children it is now a privilege that comes with being the oldest members

of the school and as role models for our younger students.
