**Reception Sports Day**

A reminder that our annual Sports Day for children in Reception will be held on the school field on **Tuesday 23rd June (1.30-3.00)**.

Children in Reception have been working hard to prepare for the exciting event: children will have the opportunity to participate in several events. After each event, children will receive stickers; you are welcome to take photos of your child but please be mindful that these should not be uploaded onto social media if they contain images of any other children.

We would love to see families and friends coming along to support the children. The field can be accessed via the gate on Nicholls Avenue, opposite the main KS2 playground. We encourage spectators to walk where possible. If driving, please do not park near the school gates or block residents' driveways. Reasonably-priced refreshments will be available throughout the event.

During Sports Day, children will remain with school staff in their class areas and must only leave their designated area when competing in an event. Spectators are respectfully asked to remain in the parents' area in between the events. At the end of the event, all children will return to class ahead of the usual dismissal routine from classrooms.

We ask that children arrive in school wearing a plain or brightly coloured t-shirt, tracksuit bottoms or shorts and trainers (in order for them to be comfortable whilst completing the events). Long hair should be tied back and all jewellery removed. Children will also require a water bottle and a sun hat (and please apply sunscreen to your child on the morning of the event).

Whilst we are really looking forward to our sports days, we are aware of the unpredictability of the British weather. If it is raining, or rain is forecast, then a decision will be made about whether to go ahead on the morning of the event. Messages will be posted on the school gates to clarify the situation and emails will also be sent out.

We look forward to seeing as many parents and carers as possible at these events.
