Teachers work within a supportive team overseen by a Year Group Leader. All subject planning is in place on Google Drive for teachers to adapt to the needs of their pupils. Specialist subject teachers cover PPA, we have a pool of dedicated learning support assistants, and administrative support to manage data collection and input.

We have an established leadership structure and take pride in supporting our staff to develop their subject expertise, leadership and management skills, be it through our internal succession planning or strong external partnerships.
