### Progress in Key Stage 2

It is expected that all pupils make at least two levels of progress from the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2) to the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6).

- The percentage of pupils who made two levels progress exceeded the national average in all subjects.
- Targets set by the Governing Body were exceeded in all subjects.
