Summary of Achievement 2012/13

Progress in Key Stage 2

It is expected that all pupils make at least two levels of progress from the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2) to the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6).

The percentage of pupils who made two levels progress exceeded the national average in all subjects.

The percentage of pupils making better than expected progress (3 levels progress) also exceeded national benchmarks

Attainment at the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6)

By the end of Key Stage 2, it is expected that pupils are working at Level 4 or above.

The percentage of pupils achieving a Level 4+ exceeded the national average in all subjects
