Summary of Achievement 2014/15

Progress in Key Stage 2

It is expected that all pupils make at least two levels of progress from the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2) to the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6).

The percentage of pupils who made two levels progress exceeded the (2014) national average in all subjects.

Phonics Screening Check Results (End of Year 1)

At the end of Year 1, all pupils are tested to confirm that they have reached the expected standard for 6 year olds in phonic decoding, a key reading skill. In 2015, **92%** of all Hillingdon Primary Year 1 pupils passed this test. This was well above the national average (for 2014) of 74%.
