Staff continue to work hard to provide high quality learning materials for students via the Early Years website. This website is updated constantly based on parent feedback and student engagement. We are very impressed with the use of the website by our youngest learners - the website has now been viewed almost 15,000 times!

## Reception children can now:

- Submit work to their teacher via the 'work that can be submitted' page
- Creations from home can be sent in and viewed on the 'wow work' page with comments from teachers
- You can listen to your teacher read a book in the 'story corner'
- Parents continue to '<u>check in</u>' once a week to let us know that you are able to access this

The Nursery page is updated weekly with a new theme. We have already had Teddy Bears and Space, these are archived and can be viewed on the webpage. New stories, activities and ideas for home learning are given each week. If you feel your child would benefit from more of a challenge, feel free to access the Reception links on the website. However, there is no expectation for Nursery age children to be able to complete the Reception home learning.

Over the last six weeks we have been in contact with various families including pupils with EHC plans. We have identified students not accessing home learning regularly and are speaking with families to provide support and to try and resolve difficulties. We do know that accessing technology for some students is not easy.
