PENCIL CASE AND STATIONERY EQUIPMENT

It is essential that children have their own equipment in school and it is preferable for parents to purchase these for their children to minimise the risk of spreading infection. Rucksacks or large bags will not be required and therefore not permitted on site. We recommend the purchase of a school bookbag available from Mapac which can be stored easily in school.

These items should be in a simple pencil case, that is clearly labelled and does not have games or novelties attached to it. Inappropriate or unsafe equipment will be sent home. The list below explains what items are essential for your child to have available to them in their pencil case.

If your child is in Nursery:

- ✓ Crayons
- ✓ Colouring pencils
- ✓ Colouring felt tips
- ✓ Chalk
- ✓ Glue stick (good quality)
- ✓ Small rounded end scissors

If your child is in Reception:

- ✓ 2 x HB pencils (triangular shaped pencils are welcomed)
- ✓ Pencil sharpener
- ✓ Crayons
- ✓ Rubber (we prefer children to neatly cross out errors, but there are some occasions when rubbers are useful)
- ✓ Glue stick (good quality)
- ✓ Separate pencil case with colouring pencils
- ✓ Small rounded end scissors

If your child is in KS1/KS2 (Yr1-6):

- ✓ 2 x HB pencils
- ✓ Pencil sharpener
- ✓ Ruler for underlining
- ✓ Rubber (we prefer children to neatly cross out errors, but there are some occasions when rubbers are useful)
- ✓ Glue stick (good quality)
- ✓ Green handwriting pen for editing work (a biro is acceptable but not gel pens and not fluorescent green).
- ✓ Separate pencil case with colouring pencils
- ✓ Small rounded end scissors

In KS2, handwriting pens will be provided by the school once children have been awarded their pen license.
