PE kits - KS1 and KS2

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your ongoing support while we continue to work on establishing new routines and systems, while ensuring that we work within the Government guidance. There is specific guidance for the PE curriculum that we have worked through in order to establish PE lessons in school, and days on which each class will be doing PE. Further information regarding PE in Reception will follow soon.

PE kits

- On days indicated on the tables below, students have a PE lesson and they should come to school dressed for PE and wearing trainers (no football or astro turf boots). In warm weather they can wear their t-shirt and shorts but in colder weather they should wear navy blue jogging bottoms which are also part of the school uniform. However, if students do not have navy blue jogging bottoms then suitable jogging bottoms of any colour can be worn for the autumn term. We would appreciate all students being in the correct uniform for the spring term. They do not need to bring their usual school uniform into school on their PE days.
- Students will also need to make sure they bring a coat or light waterproof coat to move between the school site and field, if needed. We have no intention of using the field in heavy rain but we may have to move between light rain showers. It is important that we maintain our students' level of fitness for their physical well being and give them an opportunity to be outside as much as possible, as this is a positive way of mitigating the virus. All students will need trainers (or another suitable change of footwear) as we plan to use the school field as much as possible during the autumn term. Trainers should remain on the school site so they are available to use each day. Foot wear should be inexpensive as it is likely to become muddy as we move towards winter.
- We are all adjusting to new ways of working. If your child accidentally wears their PE kit on a day not assigned to their class, it is not a problem. Their class teacher will remind them of the days they need to come to school in their kit.

PE days

Please see the days your child has PE; your child's class teacher will explain the information in this letter to the class. They should come to school dressed in their PE kits on these days. All students have two hours of PE a week. For some classes, this is taught on the same day; for other classes, this time allocation is taught across two days. **This PE timetable will be in place and will start from Monday 21st September.** PE will be taking place on the field. We aim to keep these PE days in place for this half term. When weather

conditions change later on in the second half term, PE days may change. Any timetable changes will be communicated with you in advance.
