## Information on Remote Learning for Year 1 to Year 6

Dear Parent and Carer,

Your class teacher is now preparing high quality online learning which will begin tomorrow and will run through to Friday 15th January. The learning will take place through our Remote Learning Provision on Google Classroom. Your child will be familiar with Google Classroom as they sign into it weekly with their teachers using the school's Chromebooks but may need support when signing it at home with a different device. If using a mobile or tablet device, please ensure you first download both the Google Classroom App, and the Google Slides app. For more support on this, please visit this site.

Each day there will be an English and Maths lesson. Throughout the week there will be Foundation and Science lessons. Class teachers will use recorded videos to deliver new learning and provide online activities for your child to complete. Feedback will be given to children through Google Classroom and children are encouraged to review this feedback.

When a child completes a lesson, they must click the 'Hand In' button so the teacher knows their work is complete. All lessons are due for 3pm that day, but children are welcome to submit work after this time.

The Elliot Foundation are currently reviewing the latest on video calls, and for the time being we will not be running live video calls with children.

Children in Years 1 to 3 will receive their login details via an email to you. Should children in Years 4 - 6 need support with their login, please use this link to request it.
