Remote Learning Provision for children in Class 6H

Dear Parents and Carers,

While your child is isolating at home, they will be able to access remote learning provision online. Your child's class teacher is now preparing high quality online learning which will be ready to begin on Monday 28th June and will run through to, and including, Thursday 1st July.

For tomorrow (Friday 25th June), learning has been set up on the home learning websites by your child's class teacher. These websites are: Bug Club for reading, MyMaths for maths, Spelling Shed for spellings and TT Rockstars for times table practice. Your class teacher will hold two video calls to introduce and feedback this learning to the class, via a link posted on Google Classroom. The calls will be at 9:30am and 2:15pm.

The learning for next week will take place through our Remote Learning Provision on Google Classroom. If using a mobile or tablet device, please ensure you first download both the Google Classroom App, and the Google Slides app. For more support on this, please visit this site.

There will also be two video calls held each day, which your child can access through links which will be posted in Google Classroom. Video calls will last for 15 minutes and will be at 9:30 am and 2:15pm.

Over the course of the day, there will be one Maths lesson, one English lesson and either one Science or Foundation lesson for your child to complete each day. Your child's teacher will use recorded videos to deliver new learning, and provide online activities for your child to complete. Feedback will be given to children through Google Classroom.

When a child completes a lesson, they must click the 'Hand In' button so the teacher knows their work is complete. All lessons are due for 3pm that day, but we appreciate this might not be possible in some situations and your child is welcome to submit work after this time.
