### KS2 Sports Day

This year our annual Sports Day will be held on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July. The children have been working hard both in their PE lessons and in class to prepare for the exciting event! The KS2 Sports Day, which is for years 3-6, will this year be split into two separate events. Year 4 and 6 event will be held in the morning, beginning at 9.30am and the year 3 and 5 event will be held in the afternoon, beginning at 1pm. As a growing school, separating the year groups should allow for a more succinct and energised event. We aim to finish the year 4 and 6 event approximately by noon and the Year 3 and 5 event at approximately 3pm.

All children will have the opportunity to participate in 6 field events and a minimum of 2 races. A programme of events will be available at the entrance to the field. After each race, there will be a prize-giving ceremony on podiums located close to the track finish. If your child is involved, please feel free to come and watch the ceremony. You are welcome to take photos, but please be reminded that these should not be uploaded onto social media if they contain images of any other children.

It would be wonderful to see friends and family come along to support the children. The field can be accessed by a gate off Nicholls Avenue, which runs adjacent to the KS2 playground. We would encourage supporters to walk to the event rather than driving. If you do need to drive, we would appreciate it if you did not park close to the entrance, for safety reasons.

During Sports Day, children must remain with their teachers in their class areas and must only leave their designated area when competing in an event. Parents are respectfully asked to remain in the Parents' Area on the other side of the track. At the end of the event, all children will return to class. Year 3 and 5 will be dismissed from their usual dismissal point after sports day has finished.

Please ensure that your child arrives at school in their P.E. kit (shorts, T-shirt and plimsolls/trainers). Long hair should be tied back and all jewellery removed. Children are encouraged to wear a T-shirt in their house colour, please see the colour for each class below. Your child will also require a water bottle, a sun hat and a small towel if they cannot sit on the grass due to allergies. Please apply sun cream to your child on the morning of the event.
