Reminder: End of Term Arrangements

The end of the autumn term is a time of great excitement in our school community as it is in primary schools across the country. We are mindful that many of our children, families and staff do not celebrate Christmas as a religious festival although many do. However, as a community we have always taken the opportunity to take part in traditions built up over many years such as the decorated Christmas tree in the school hall, the excited singing of Jingle Bells and Frosty the Snowman and the Christmas Fayre. It is also an opportunity to remind ourselves of the important message of peace and goodwill to all.

This year, the money raised at the school fayre will go towards a school library in the newly refurbished site house. We had hoped to be able to buy library furniture (£16,000) from the school budget but due to rising costs that is not possible at present. How can you help? Please join us at the school fayre and buy the gifts prepared by the children and staff. Please come and help with setting up the hall. Please make a donation for our raffle. If you are unable to do any of these things please consider making a separate donation towards our library. Please read the information at the bottom of this letter for what you need to do if you can help in any way - thank-you.

During the last week of term, RE Week takes place. We focus on the Christian festival of Christmas. RE Week provides an opportunity for our pupils to learn about what Christians believe and to compare and contrast it with their own beliefs and values. It is very important to us that our children learn about different world religions including Christianity. We teach them to have a respectful understanding of the differing viewpoints, perspectives and beliefs within our own school community and beyond. This year pupils can choose to bring in cards. If they prefer they can bring in one card for the class to be displayed. Cards should be posted in the post box near the main school entrance and will be delivered to classrooms at lunch time.
