As part of our Computing and Personal development curriculum we value the importance of being safe online and the staff and children of Hillingdon Primary School are pleased to be a part of this global event.

SAFER INTERNET DAY

Safer Internet Day is more important today than it has ever been. Safer Internet Day is celebrated annually in over 100 countries. The day offers the opportunity to celebrate young people's role in creating a safer internet, whether that is whilst gaming and creating content, or interacting with their friends and peers. This year's theme is *'Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online.'*

We will mark this by a special assembly for the students from our Digital Leaders and lessons tailored to each key stage on keeping safe online on the week beginning 6th February 2023. Our focus will be on children discussing with their peers and their teachers their use of technology in school as well as outside of school and how to keep safe online. During special Safer Internet Day lessons, children and teachers will debate when and how to ask for help as well as wise and sensible use of technology according to children's age.

Attached to this letter is a home learning activity to start this discussion with families. We would encourage parents and carers to gather together with the whole family, including younger and older siblings, to discuss the statements sent home. We feel this will give families a wonderful opportunity to open a discussion at home about technology. Children are then encouraged to bring this back in to help with the discussion we will have in school during the week.


